Being the youngest member of the Turkish IPU Group, I have a great honour to share with you my candidacy to the vacant position for the Board of Young Parliamentarians.

I was born in 1992 in Ankara. I completed first and secondary education at TED Ankara College. I graduated from high school with an International Baccalaureate diploma. Afterward, I completed my undergraduate education at Bilkent University Faculty of Law in 2014. After one year of legal internship, I worked as an active lawyer for 3 years in the fields of energy, information technologies, and space law.

During my university education, I participated in such social activities for strengthening education in disadvantaged regions of Turkey.

In 2014, in the AK Party's Youth Congress, which is the most inclusive youth movement of Turkey with its 1.5 million members, I was elected as the Vice President in charge of Public Relations. In the meantime, I traveled around various cities of Turkey and arranged well-attended, common wisdom meetings with non-governmental organizations.

In the AK Party's convention of 2017, I left the youth branch of party and was elected as a member of the AK Party Central Disciplinary Board, and I became the youngest member of the Central Disciplinary Board. I also carried on the duty of Vice-Chairmanship of Publicity and Media at the Headquarters of AK Party.

In the general elections of Turkey which were held in 2018, I was elected as a member of the parliament from the second electoral district of Ankara, as one of the youngest MPs of Turkey.

In a rapidly digitizing world, I continue my legislative activities in order to integrate the legal systems of the country into new economic order; I also study on the subjects of protection of personal data in the concept of human rights and protection of personal rights and freedoms on the social media platforms. In this context, I have contributed to the preparation of the Law which is known as the social media law, in the Grand National Assembly of Turkey.


I attach great importance to implement youth and rural development projects simultaneously. While I am continuing to study on strengthening vocational and technical education in Turkey, I also achieve specific projects on climate change and digital agriculture for rural development. I am member of the Committee on National Education, Culture, Youth, and Sports and spokesperson of the Committee on Digital Platforms. I also served as a member of the Investigation Committee on Animal Rights. I am chair of Turkey-Namibia Inter-Parliamentary Friendship Group and alternate member of Parliamentary Assembly of the Council of Europe.

Modern technology and science introduced new systems of production, regulation, conception, information and know-how. Technology, has advanced in to many areas of life. Today our societies are becoming more and more dependent on technology and showing no signs of the decreasing their dependencies. Regulating this relationship between technology and society remains essential.
