The IPU secretary's office informed us that during the present Assembly our group should fill a vacant post at the **Parliamentarian women's board**.

The French delegation presents of Ms. Véronique Riotton's candidacy, french deputy.

Very involved in equality and gender issues, Véronique Riotton cosigned several bills, which included the ones aiming to fight against violence against women and to accelerate professional equality, but also the one intended to secure nursery assistants' right to protection, a mainly female employment. In addition, she actively contributed to the great consultation about domestic violence, named "Grenelle". Finally, within the National assembly, her co-workers trusted her to chair during few months the Sustainable development, town, and country planning commission.
